Callers can receive referral information for reentry needs, including online/telemedicine services such as medical/dental services, mental health services, as well as entitlements, linkage to housing, employment, legal support, and COVID-19 specific concerns and testing, if warranted.



REENTRY KITS

COVID-19 Reentry Kits provide important items during the first few weeks in the community while many stores are closed and services are limited, including smart phones, personal hygiene products, gift cards for emergency food, clothing and medical co-pays; masks and additional items for personal use.
